Endodontic Post-Treatment Instructions

Your root canal treatment is not finished. Your next appointment is scheduled on _____

Your root canal treatment is finished.
Please schedule another appointment with your dentist for the final restoration.

- It is common to have mild/moderate soreness for 3-5 days. Soft foods are best during this period.
- You may have a temporary restoration on your tooth. It is common for this restoration to be worn down in between appointments (it may feel like you have a hole on the top of your tooth).
- Please take the following for discomfort:
 - Advil [Ibuprofen] - 600mg
 - Take 600mg every 6 hours (no more than 4 times per day) as needed for pain
 - If you take blood thinners, are pregnant/nursing, or have stomach, gastrointestinal, kidney, or bleeding problems please consult with Dr. Crepps before taking this medication.
 - Tylenol [Acetaminophen] – 500mg – 650 mg
 - Take 500mg – 650mg every 6 hours (no more than 4 times per day) as needed for pain
 - If you have liver problems, please consult with Dr. Crepps before taking this medication.
 - Do not take additional Tylenol/Acetaminophen while taking this medication (such as Vicodin, Percocet, or Norco).

If your pain is unrelieved with the recommended medications, if you notice swelling, or if you have a fever, contact us:
